

PUPIL COMPUTER AND INTERNET USER AGREEMENT

At St Jude's school, we expect all pupils to be responsible for their own behaviour on computers and the Internet, just as they are anywhere else in school. This includes materials they choose to access, and language they use.

This is to be read through with your parent(s) and then signed. You will be allowed Internet Access after this is returned to school. These rules will keep you safe and help us be fair to others.

General Computer Use

- I will only access the system through the proper log-in and will keep any passwords secret
- I will not access other people's files
- I will only use the computers for school work and homework
- I will not bring CDs or other storage devices from outside school unless I have been given permission by my teacher
- I will not use the printers unless I have permission from a teacher
- I will not use any rude language in my work.

Internet User Agreement

- I will ask permission from a member of staff **before** using the internet
- I will not download any files from the internet
- I will not access social network sites or instant messaging services
- I will not be involved in sending chain letters
- I will only email people I know, or my teacher has approved
- The messages I send will be polite and responsible
- I will not give my home address or telephone number, or arrange to meet someone
- If I see anything that is rude, or worries and upsets me, I will tell a teacher **immediately**. I know that what I say will be confidential and will help to protect other pupils and myself
- I understand that the school may check my computer files and may monitor the internet sites I visit.
- **I know that if I break these rules, I may lose access to the computers and the internet in school.**
