Online Safety Top Tip of the Week

Remember that the same safety rules for surfing the internet apply to playing games on the internet. Familiarise yourselves with the SMART rules:

S = Safe. Do not give out personal information when chatting or posting online.

M = Meeting. Meeting someone one has only been in touch with online can be dangerous.

A = Accepting. Accepting emails, IM messages, or opening files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems.

R = Reliable. Someone online might lie about who they are and information on the internet may not be true.

T = Tell. Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried.
