Top tips for staying helping to keep your child safe on YouTube



1. Enable Safety Mode on your home computers - go to the bottom of any YouTube page and turn Safety Mode on.



2. Disable the YouTube app on tablets and mobiles - keep in mind that there is no Safety Mode on the YouTube mobile app.



3. Use a child-safe browser on your mobile devices – Safari can be disabled and, by using a browser such as Kiddle instead, YouTube videos can't be viewed via the internet.
