

Science – Animals (inc. humans)

- We will start by studying the process of digestion and what happens to our food.
- Looking at different organs and their roles in the human body.
- Identify the importance of the mouth and teeth. Why aren't all teeth the same?
- Looking at how to look after our teeth and the consequences of not doing so.
- Understanding how to ensure a test is fair.

PSHE:

- The unit we will be covering is Being Me in My World.
- These sessions will help us to allow others to feel welcome and consider other people's feelings, as well as our own.

ICT:

- Discuss e-safety – videos and interactive activities.
- Including relevant information in a multimedia presentation.
- Conducting our own research, with particular focus on finding out information on Ancient Egypt.

P.E:

- This half term PE will be outdoors and will focus on football skills.

Mathematics – Multiplication & Division

- Place value.
- Ordering and comparing numbers.
- Using objects to identify numbers.
- Addition and subtraction facts.
- Using number facts to add and subtract.

History/Geography:

- We will look at the role of Pharaohs in Ancient Egypt.
- Understanding the different gods and goddesses that Egyptians worshipped.
- Describe some of the inventions of the ancient Egyptians.
- Locating the River Nile on a map.
- Use adjectives to describe what life in Ancient Egypt was like.
- Identifying tourist attractions of Egypt.

R.E:

- We will be looking at the life of Moses and his role.
- The focus will be on stories from the Old Testament.
- Learning about the ten plagues and why the Israelites were protected from the last plague.
- Understanding the rules that God gave Moses and the importance of rules in our society.

Art & DT:

- The children will create their own Egyptian necklaces.
- Use a sketchbook for different techniques such as paper Mache.
- We will be having a topic day and will make Pyramids using sugar cubes.

Music:

- Learn about Ancient Egyptians through songs and instruments
- Dimensions of Music
- Musitrax
- Listening and Appraising a different musical genre each week

Writing / drama: There's a Pharaoh in our bath!

- To support our topic work we will be reading a fantastic novel by Jeremy Strong.
- The children will read stories about the pharaohs and act out scenes.
- They will complete their own stories on the information they have gathered.
- We will be reading Secrets of a Sun King by Emma Carroll as our first class novel.
- Tasks will involve presenting their findings to other classes across the school.
