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

We have been very busy learning about our new topics this week in Year 2! On Monday we explored our new topic of 'The Circus is Coming to Town!' by using lots of props we would have at a circus and watching real life circus performances from around the world. We dressed up as different performers and used this to help us collect some wonderful vocabulary about the circus. We had a great time! Also, we have been fact finders and read lots of new circus information to help us gain more knowledge of our new topic!





The PTA agreed to match the funding from Lambeth to make this happen and has ring fenced this funding so we are now considering our next steps. Many of you feel strongly about the benefits the green screen would have provided for pupils and now with the added traffic on Dulwich Road it's arguably more important than ever.
