Year 4's Learning This Week


In Year 4 we have been having acting sections in our class text to make reading sessions fun and creative. This week we summarised a chapter from the story 'There's a Pharaoh in our baths'. We acted out the part where Jelly and Grimstone are plotting how they will take the treasure map from Sennapod.



Grimstone (Natan) is planning how to trick Sennapod (Angus) with his blunderbuss. (Heath) Jelly is giving Grimstone information about where Sennapod is. Sennapod (Angus) is ready to go into the museum with Mr Lightspeed (Merryn) and Mrs Lightspeed (Anna).





In maths, we have been practising column addition and subtraction by regrouping. We used counters and a place value grid to represent it in different ways.



In art, we created our final piece of artwork. We drew hieroglyphic messages on the papyrus paper we made. To do this we used oil pastels and considered the mood we wanted to create in our work. We used inspiration from artists like Amrita Sher-Gil and Afwerk Tekle and the way they created mood in their artwork. This has included how warm and cool colours create mood.
