

English:

- Children will be researching their local area, inspired by the text 'A Walk in London'.
- Children will be writing recounts and information about a walk in Herne Hill.
- We will be writing poetry about our environment inspired by 'Changing the Guards at Buckingham Palace'.
- We will be performing our poetry from memory.

Computing:

- Our unit this half term is on using spreadsheets (Excel) and entering data and formula into them.

Art & Design: Art in London

- Children will use a range of materials to recreate London's Landscape including watercolour and different pencils.
- Children will learn about street art in London.

Humanities:

- Identify human and physical features of London.
- Look at pictures of London and how it has changed - compare and contrast.
- Identify London's climate and begin to explain why it has this climate.
- Explore how London's transport has changed over time.
- Develop our fieldwork skills.
- Ask and answer geographical questions.

PE:

- We will be practising throwing and catching skills and invasion game tactics through the sport of rugby.

Science:

- Children will be learning about how rocks are formed.
- Children will be learning about different types of rocks.
- Children will plan and implement scientific investigation including setting up and learning about how to investigate in a fair way.
- Children will learn about fossil and soil formation.
- We will be taking part in gardening workshops to support our learning about soil formation.

Music:

- We will be learning about rhythm through games and creating our own rhythms.

RE:

- Children will be learning about Jesus' new commandments and his two greatest commandments.
- Children will be learning about advent.

Maths:

- Children will be focussing on addition and subtraction.
- Children will learn to regroup using a range of resources.
- Children will continue to apply number skills to assist with addition, subtraction and multiplication.
