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


Year 5's Learning this Week

In RE the children have been learning about bishops in the Church of England. Last week the children researched bishops. This week the children presented their research projects. Some children created slides, some children created videos or posters.




What is a bishop?


A bishop is a church leader of the church of England.



Class 5






World Book Day !
