

English:

- Our class text this half term is Beowulf- a retelling of the Anglo Saxon legend
- We will be focussing on using adverbials to sequence and conjunctions to extend out sentences
- We will be rehearsing our sentences verbally before writing
- We will focus on editing and improving our work independently thinking about audience and purpose.
- We will be retelling a know legend in our own words
- We will continue to work on punctuating speech accurately

Art & Design:

- We will be learning about the process of weaving and creating our own Anglo Saxon textiles in the way Anglo Saxons did!

Food Technology:

- Baking and tasting Anglo Saxon bread.

Humanities:

We will learn about:

- Who the Anglo-Saxons were, where they came from and why they came to Britain
- The significance of Alfred the Great
- What life was like in Anglo Saxon Britain – how people lived and what they believed.

Computing:

We will learn:

- How to keep ourselves safe online, understanding what information we can share and what we need to keep private
- How to use a search engine effectively, and evaluate the content we have found.



Maths:

- We will begin by continuing to use our 2,4 and 8 times tables.
- We will compare statements, learn related calculations, multiply 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers and learn scaling.
- After this we will focus on money learning how to count in pence and pounds, convert, add using money and give change.
- We will finish by focusing on statistics learning how to make tally charts, pictograms, bar charts and tables.
