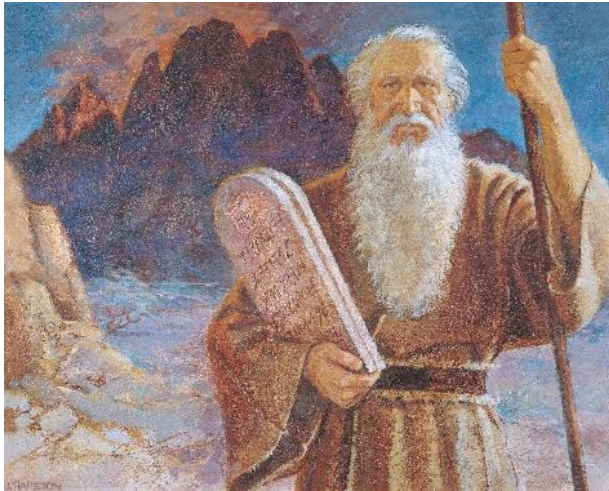


How do Christians believe following Jesus' commandments makes a difference?

Key Vocabulary

Commandment - a divine rule, especially one of the Ten Commandments.

Moses - also known as Moshe Rabbenu is considered the most important prophet in Judaism, and an important prophet in Christianity and Islam.

Tablets of Stone - the two stone tablets inscribed with the Ten Commandments when Moses ascended Mount Sinai.

Epiphany - the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles as represented by the Magi (Matthew 2:1-12).

Following - a body of supporters or admirers.

Mount Sinai - the place where, according to the Bible, Moses received the Ten Commandments.
