## Key Vocabulary:

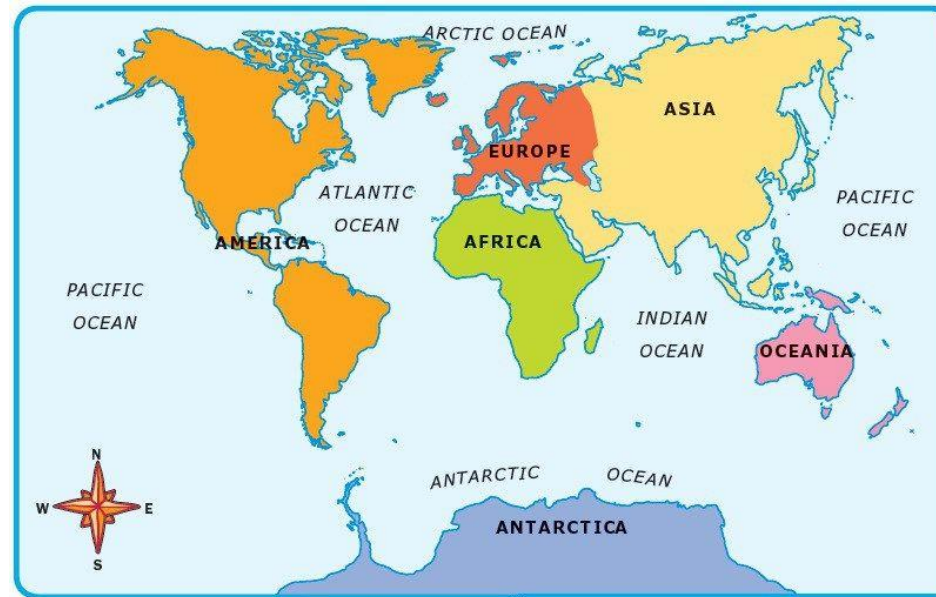
**explorer** - a person who explores an area that is not known

**needle** that points north.

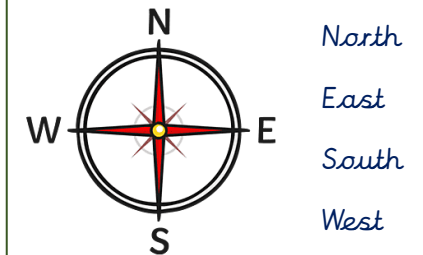
**sources** - contains historical information
