The children will be asked to take their recorder or ukulele home to practise their new skills; it is essential that the children do practise at home to ensure they are making progress between lessons. Children taking part in music tuition should bring in their instrument every Monday.

This half term our topic is 'Our Wonderful World'. We will be learning about recycling, the environment and the natural habitat around us. We will also be learning about art linked to recycling.
