Dear Parents and Carers of Year 4,

Welcome back! I hope that you have all had a great summer holiday and are ready for an action packed year! I am delighted to be teaching your children this year and will be supported by Miss Stewart and Mr Cutts.

The children will be having PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays: one indoor and one outdoor lesson. They should come into school in their PE kit on these days. Please ensure that your child's uniforms, PE kit, and book bags are clearly labelled with their name and class to ensure that they can be found if they are misplaced.

Like last year, home learning will be uploaded on to Google Classroom on a Thursday and handed in on a Tuesday. Please support your children with their home learning as it is an extension of their school learning. There will be a mathematics and spelling task based on the learning the children have been doing that week. If your child is experiencing difficulties in completing the home learning, please come and see me. **At the end of year 4 the children are expected to sit a multiplication check so it is important that these are regularly practised at home.**

Reading at home is part of your child's home learning task and should be done every day for at least 20 minutes. Please ensure your child hands in their **reading record** on a **Tuesday** to be checked by an adult in the room. They are expected to complete their reading record independently. There is a prompt glued in the front of their reading record to support them with things to include. Please remind your child to bring their reading book and reading record to school everyday so they are able to read during reading for pleasure time.

This term our topic is Ancient Egypt. We will be reading some exciting texts to engage our imagination and learning about the mummification process. Have a look at our topic web for more information about the activities we will be doing this half term.

If you would like to see me for a quick chat or to share anything that has recently changed for your child, I will be in the playground from 8.50am.
