

English:

- Children will be researching their local area, inspired by the text 'A Walk in London'.
- Children will be creating their own brochures, advertising Herne Hill.
- We will be writing poetry about our environment inspired by 'Changing the Guards at Buckingham Palace'.
- We will be performing our poetry from memory.

Computing: Creating Media –Animation

We will be using a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets. We will then apply those skills to create a story-based animation.

To make this topic even more relevant, and ensure the knowledge sticks, the children will be going on a trip to the Museum of London.

Art & Design

- Children will be looking at the Landscape artist Irina Rummyantseva, who is well known for her watercolour paintings of London.
- The children will be focusing on the skill of sketching and using watercolours as a medium.

PE:

- We will be practising throwing and catching skills and invasion game tactics through the sport of rugby.
- We will also be learning dance.

Science:

We will learn:

- how rocks are formed.
- about different types of rocks.
- how to plan and implement scientific investigations, including setting up and fair tests.
- about fossil and soil formation.

We will be taking part in gardening workshops to support our learning about soil formation.

Music:

Our focus in music this half term is Exploring Sounds and Poetry and using this focus to support us with Music Performance.

RE:

- Children will be learning about Jesus' new commandments and his two greatest commandments.
- Children will be learning about Advent.

Spanish:

We will be building on our learning from Autumn 1 add learning about dates and numbers in Spanish.

Humanities:

We will be learning to:


- Identify different counties within the UK

Maths:
