

What are God's rules for living?

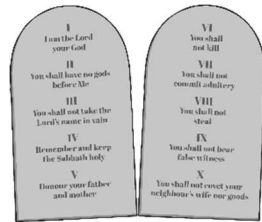
Key Vocabulary:

Never hurt others.



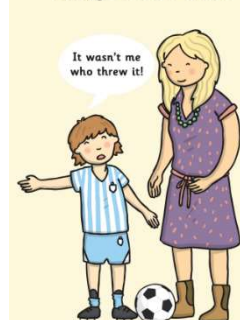
Be faithful to your husband or wife.
