*Old Testament - The Christian name for the writings that make up the first major part of the Bible. The Old Testament is also part of the Hebrew scriptures.*

*New Testament - the books of the Christian Bible that tell of the life and works of Jesus Christ and his apostles.*

*Prophet - someone who is inspired by God through the Holy Spirit to deliver a message.*

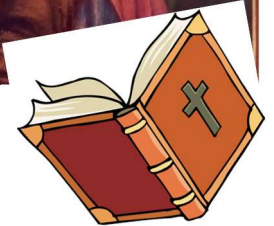
*Apostle - one of the first twelve disciples of Jesus Christ.*

*Version - a particular form of something.*

*Metanarrative - There are many versions of the Bible, but the contents all tell a 'big story,' the story of God's relationship with the people He made. This is known as the 'metanarrative,' meaning the Bible's 'big story.'*

*Christian - a member of a Christian church, and someone who believes in the divine nature of Jesus Christ and follows his words and teachings.*
