

# Animals

## Key vocabulary:

- *amphibians* - they live in the water as babies and on land as they get older.
- *birds* - All birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.
- *fish* - Fish live and breathe underwater. They have scaly skin, fins to help them swim and they breathe through gills.
- *mammals* - Animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.
- *reptiles* - All reptiles breathe air and have scales on their skin.
