evergreen trees - keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter

deciduous trees - loses its leaves each year

wild plants - it doesn't need to be planted or cared for

garden plants - people choose to grow in their gardens

roots - take in water

stem - hold the plant up and carry water from roots

leaves - catch sunlight to help make food

flowers - attract insects and birds

petals - colourful part of the flower

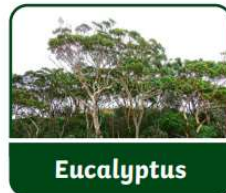
Links

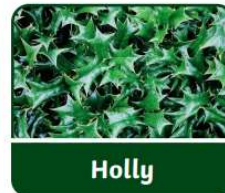

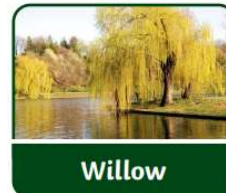
