Key Vocabulary:

adult - fully grown plant or animal.

life cycle - changes living things go through to become an adult.

offspring - the child of an adult.

young - offspring that has not yet become an adult.

live young - offspring that has not hatched from an egg.

Some animals give birth to **live young**.

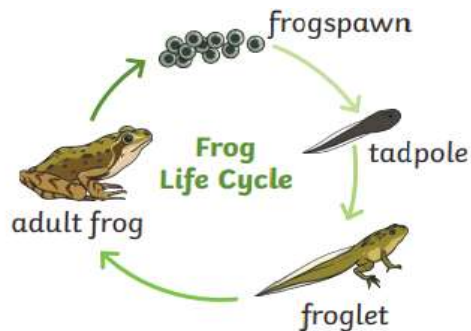


Some animals lay eggs which the **young** hatch from.
