Invasion - To enter a country with plans to rule it.

Settlement - a place where people live.

Danelaw - a law that created peace between the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings.

Warrior - a brave and experienced soldier or fighter.

Monastery - a building/buildings for monks and nuns.

Valhalla - the afterlife in Norse mythology.

Viking raids- surprise Viking attacks on their enemies.

Conquest - the control of a place or people by military control.

Vikings - from Scandinavia, Denmark, Norway and Sweden

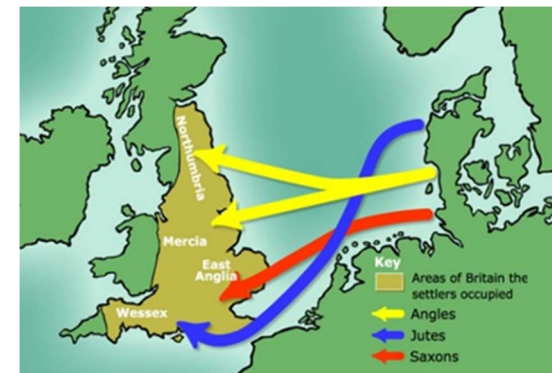


Normans - from France
