

Bright Sparks: Electricity

Key Vocabulary:


- Circuit: a complete route which an electric current can flow around
- Component: any electrical device that
 has distinct electrical characteristics and that
 may be connected to other electrical devices to
 form a circuit.
- Conductor: a substance that electricity can pass through or along.
- Insulator: a material with a very low electrical conductivity.
- Energy: the power from sources such as electricity
- Participle: a piece of matter smaller than an atom.





Series Circuit
