Dear Parents and Carers of Class Three,

Welcome back. I hope you have all had a lovely and restful half term and are ready for another fun filled summer half-term! We depend on your support at home, both to encourage your child in their studies and to reinforce the high expectations for good attitudes and behaviour that we have at St Jude's.

This half term our topic is 'What a wonderful world!', where we will be studying Herne Hill in detail and creating our own maps of the local area. For Design Technology, we will be looking at Mechanical systems and creating our very own pneumatic toys. We are excited that some of our children will be continuing their Ukulele, recorder and drumming tuition on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons respectively. The children will be asked to take their recorder/ ukulele home to practise their new skills; it is essential that the children do practise at home to ensure they are making progress between lessons.
