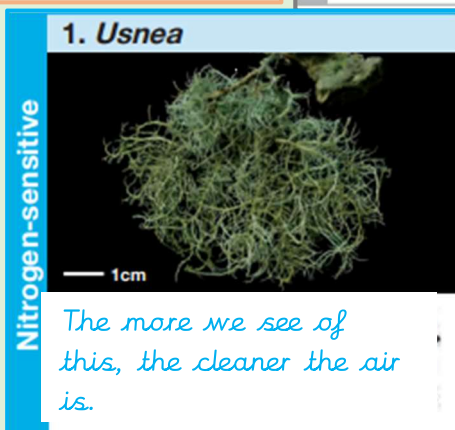
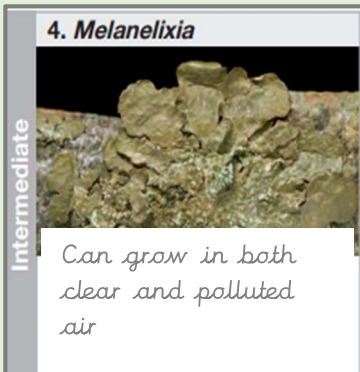
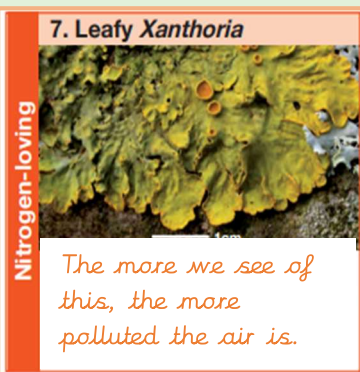
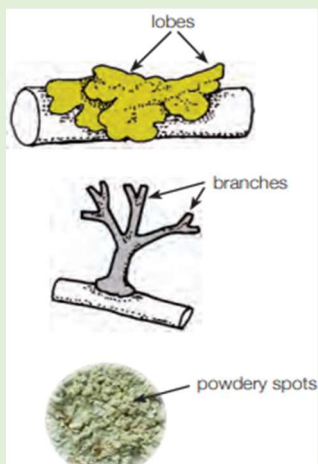


Key knowledge:

lichen - made up of two or more different organisms living together, a fungus and an algae. Some algae thrive in an area which is high in air pollution and can therefore tell us about the level of air pollution in an area.

Key Vocabulary:

climate - the weather patterns and temperature of a location.

global warming - the gradual warming of the Earth's atmosphere, oceans and surface.

climate change - climate records have shown that the Earth's atmosphere is getting warmer which is causing our climate to change.

habitat - a place that an animal or living thing lives

Key Knowledge:

Ordinance Survey maps (OS maps) show a smaller area in greater detail. A **four figure grid reference** or **six figure grid reference** tells us more precisely where about in the square something is.
