Key Vocabulary

- Human impact - the influence that humans have had on an area.

- Life expectancy - how long a person lives for.

- Biome - a habitat that has a distinct set of plants and trees living in it as well as animals. It covers large areas of the planet.
- Vegetation belt - plant life in an area.
- Environmental management - how it is that humans can try to protect the environment from becoming more damaged by global warming by putting measures in place.
