This week we welcomed in another mystery reader! We love having mystery readers come in every Friday and read a picture book to the class.







Who? Parents or Carers can meet with Ms Fender

**Why?** My working days are Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays, so I would like to offer a time solely dedicated to meeting with you about your concerns regarding your child's challenges to access the curriculum.

Where? You can choose to meet face-to-face or via telephone

When? First Friday of the month

Time? 10 minute slots between 09:30 and 12:30

**How?** Telephone the Office and request to book for SEND surgery. Bookings can be made on the week of the surgery.
