What have Year 4 been up to?

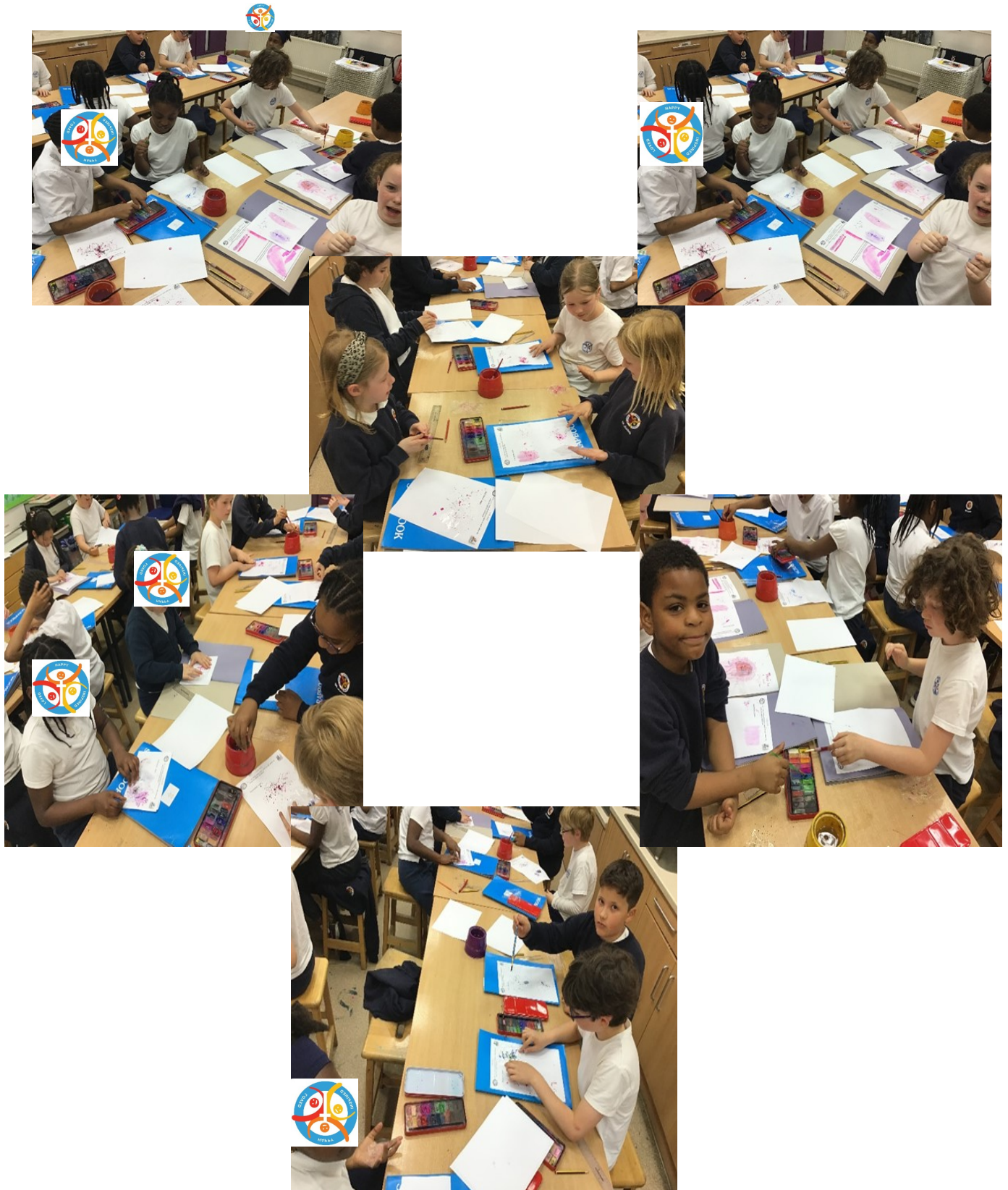

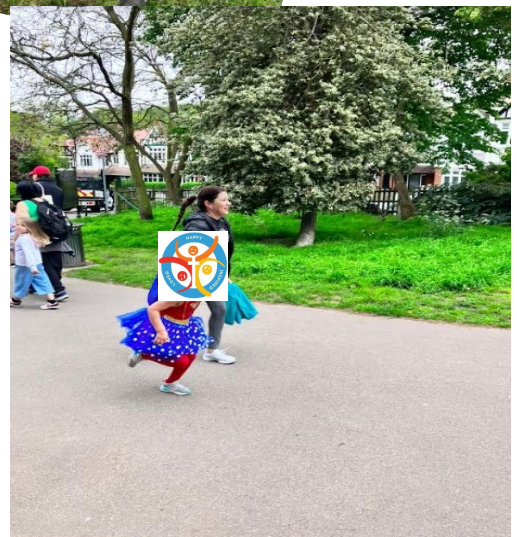
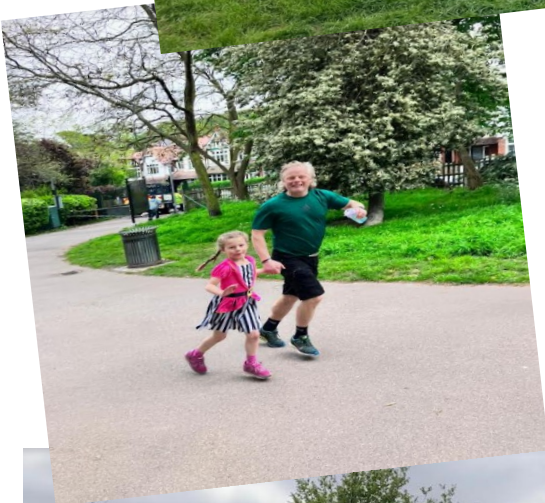

Friday Stars !

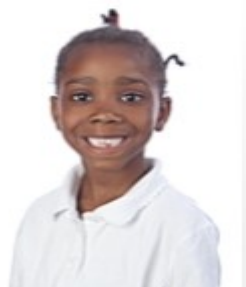
Reception

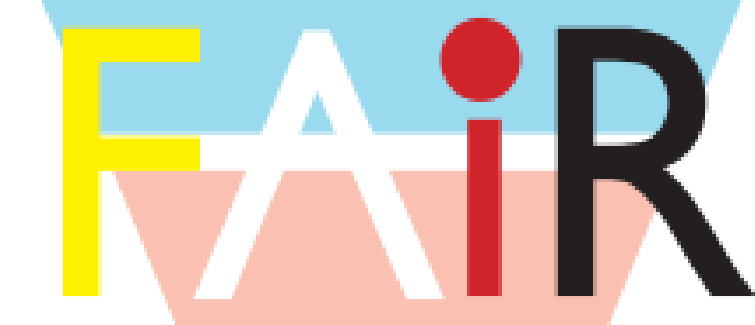
