#### **Soaring to Success!**

We are thrilled with our end of phase results for our children. It is testament to the incredible hard work from the children and staff. It is also testament to the hard work that the parents and carers do to support your children in their learning at home.

This year, our children achieved the following:

77% of our children achieved a Good Level of Development in our Reception class.

78% of our children passed the Phonics Screening Check.

73% of our Year 2 children are working at or above the expected standard in reading, writing and maths.

In Year 4, our children scored an average of 22 out of 25 on the Multiplication Check.

82% of our Year 6 children are working at or above the expected standard in reading, writing and maths.

Although the national averages have not been released in all of these areas yet, we are really happy that these results exceed national averages from 2022.
