A Very Special Visitor!

We are very excited to be welcoming professional athlete Victoria Ohuruogu to the school on **Tuesday 26th September.**

Victoria Ohuruogu is an English track athlete who competes in the 400 metres. She won the silver medal in the event at the 2022 Commonwealth Games. At the 2022 World Athletics Championships in Eugene, Oregon, Ohuruogu won the bronze medal as a member of the women's 4 x 400 metres relay team. At the 2022 European Championships, she was part of women's 4 x 400m quartet than ran the second fastest time ever by a British women's team of 3:21.74.

Victoria will be leading a **sponsored fitness circuit with all pupils** and will follow up with an assembly with a question and answer session. The aim of the event is to **inspire the pupils** to be more physically active and encourage them to discover and then pursue their **passion in life**.



The event will connect the children with a sporting role model and raise money to improve physical activity for the school, while also supporting athletes and para-athletes. Last year we raised enough money to fund a brand new set of gymnastics mats for the school. We are looking forward to what we can achieve this year!



EARLY YEARS SEN TEAM / PARENTS/CARERS INFORMATION

<u>Early Years SEN Team - Autism</u> <u>Support</u>



As part of the Early Years Sen Team the Autism Officers offer advice and support to families who have children under 5 with Autism (or awaiting diagnosis).

Children can be referred to our Service through Mary Sheridan Centre of Child Health or Children Services, such as your family practitioner at a Children's Centre.

The Service also provides short specific intervention and strategies within the home to support families with Autism this may include packages around understanding diagnosis, communication, behaviour, and use of visual aids. The Services aims to enable children with additional needs to access an Early Years provision to promote holistic development. Parents can also access specialist Autism workshops across the borough.

The Service also runs an EarlyBird Parenting Programme for families with children with an Autism diagnosis. More information about this can be found on the Lambeth Local Offer by searching EarlyBird Programme.

The Officer's collaborate with Families, Educational Settings (Nurseries/Childminders, PVI's), Children's Centre's and Children's Services across Lambeth. Children remain known to the service until they reach 5 or until they start Reception.
