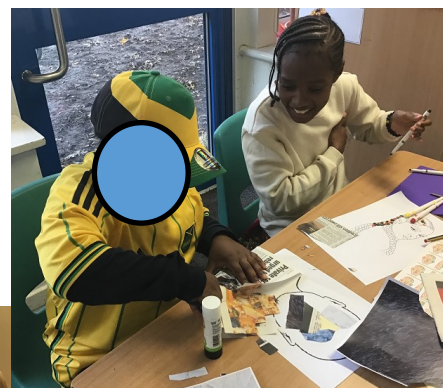

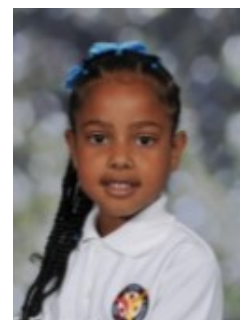
Dojo Winners
