English:

In English we will be:

- Reading The Naughty Bus and Emma Jane's aeroplane to support our writing.
- Developing our prediction skills.
- Learning the use of adjectives to make writing more detailed.
- Using words like 'and' and 'because' in our writing.

Computing:

In computing we will be learning about technology all around us.

Design Technology:
