- Learn about directions and routes.

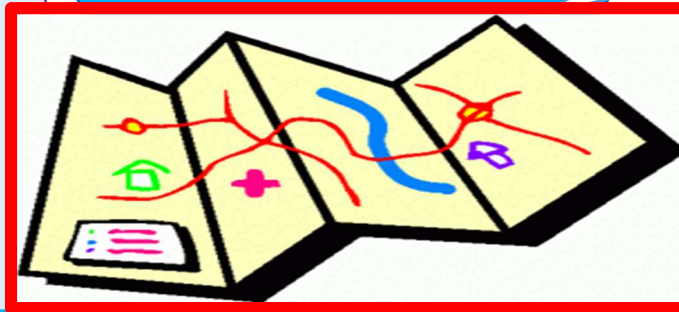
Art & Design:
