

English:

In our lessons we will be:

- reading quality texts such as The Owl and the Pussycat, and using them to inspire our own writing
- learning to improve our choice of adjective and verb
- learning to use conjunctions to extend our sentences
- learning to use apostrophes in our writing
- learning to use different suffixes to create new words
- writing for different purposes, including our own stories based on Clean up!

Computing:

In computing we will be creating digital music. We will be exploring rhythms and patterns.

Art & Design:

We will be learning about different techniques using charcoal and chalk and try to replicate them in our own artwork. We will use this to help us create shells inspired by our learning on the seaside.

Humanities:

In our lessons we will be:

- Using maps and globes to locate the seas and beaches around the UK
- Using geographical words to describe coastal areas
- Using sources to find out more about the past
- Finding out about Grace Darling and her amazing



PE:

In outdoor PE, we will be doing a series of team games where we mix skills developed in the first two terms. In indoor PE we will have some seaside dancing.

Maths:

In our maths lessons we will be:

- Using mathematical language to describe position and direction
- Telling and writing the time to five minutes
- Exploring measure using weight, length and capacity
- Reading scales in divisions of 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s
