Year 6: 7 responses

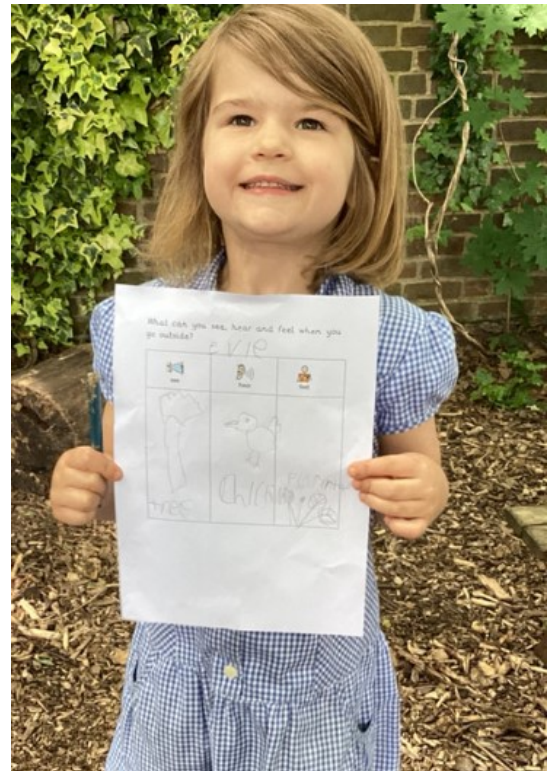
Please ensure that your child has the opportunity to complete the survey. Younger children may need an adult to sit with them to read the questions and record their responses.

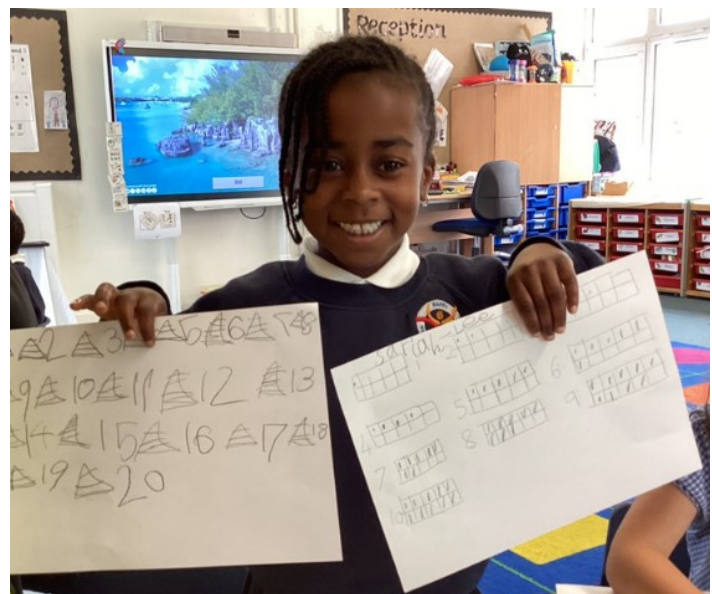
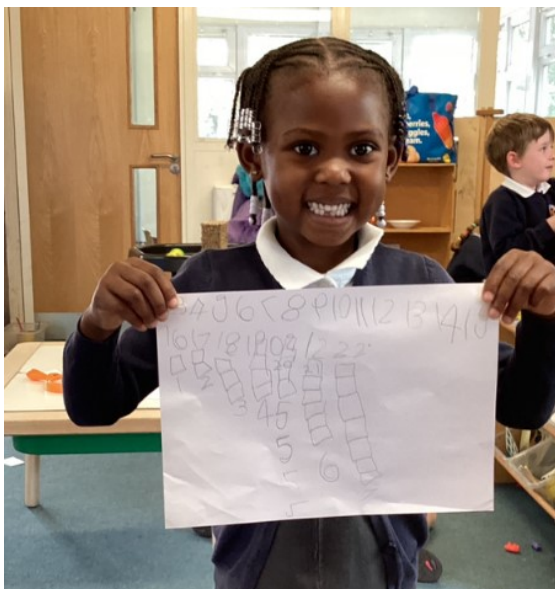


What has Reception been up to?

We have been playing the mystery number game and trying to make number lines. We have made different representations of numbers up to 20.

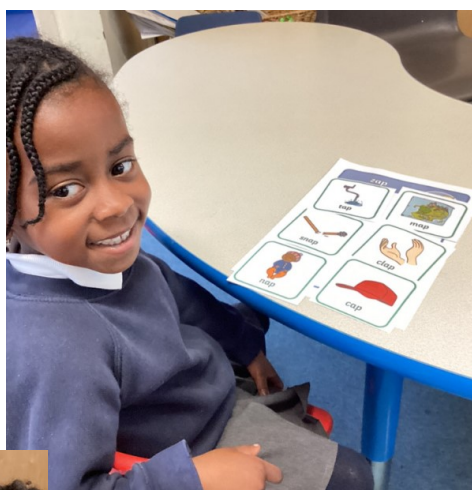


What have Reception been up to?
