# **Friday Stars!**


#### Reception

#### PE Kit

Reception children are required to come in their PE and change into their school uniform on their PE day.

All uniform should be clearly labelled so that owners can be identified easily. We cannot support children to find their items of clothing if they do not have their names in.

#### <u>Jewellery</u>

Children are allowed to wear stud earrings and a sensible watch to school. Hoop earrings should not be worn in school. We do not allow children to wear digital watches which connect to devices as these can be distracting during their learning.

#### Nail Varnish and Make Up

Children are not permitted to wear nail varnish or make up during school time.

#### **Use of Mobile Phones**



Our Family School Agreement states that all our parents and carers will

'not use mobile phones on school site to take phone calls, videos, photographs or send messages'.

This is to ensure that you are ready and available to support your child at drop off and pick up times, as well as be available to speak to a member of staff if needed.

This also includes taking photos and videos of school performances, worship, assemblies and parades.

This is out of consideration for data use and data protection preferences. When the school takes photographs and/or videos, consent has already been obtained from the parents and carers as to how this information can be used and shared.

We ask that all parents and carers respect this request. We also ask that in cases where this has occurred, incidents are reported to the Head of School or Headteacher as soon as possible, so that the correct procedure can be followed.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

#### **Musical Instruments**

If your child participated in ukulele or recorder tuition last year and is no longer taking part this year, we ask that they return all borrowed instruments to school as soon as possible. We provide these for any children taking part in weekly lessons and do not have enough if they are not returned.

# **Secondary School Applications**

If your child was born between **1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014**, or taught as a Year 6 child in the 2024-2025 school year, you must apply for a secondary school place for September 2025.

The deadline for on-time applications is midnight on **Tuesday 31 October 2024**.

If you apply online, you will be sent an email on **Monday 3 March 2025** telling you your child's school place offer. You can also check the offer on the **eAdmissions website**.

If you apply by post, an outcome letter will be sent to you by post on Monday **3 March 2025**.

If your child has an **Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP),** you'll need to apply for a school place in a different way.

See the SEND Local Offer section to read about <u>choosing and applying for a school for a child with an ECHP.</u>

Applying for a school place using the e-admissions portal when your child has an EHCP will not be valid and your child may miss out on a school place.

If your family needs any support to access the information online, please contact the school and we will be happy to help.
