Friday Stars !

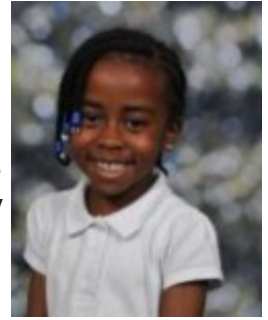
Reception

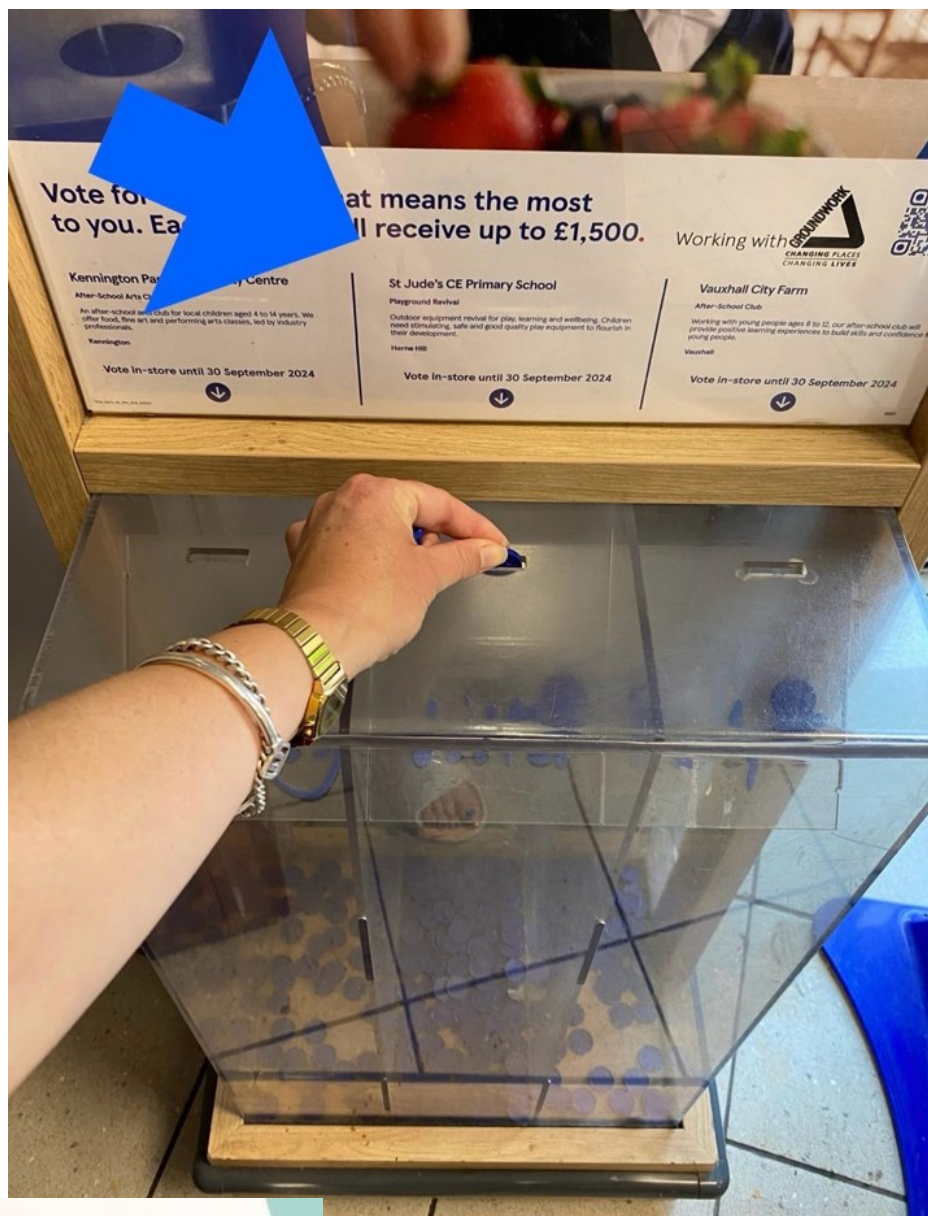

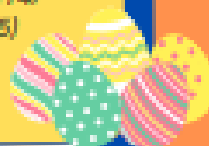

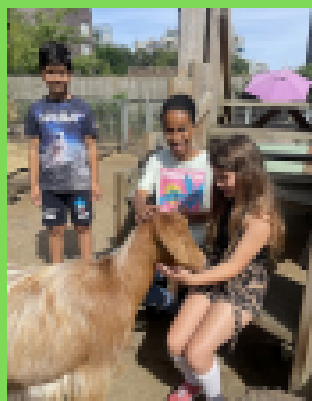
