## What has Class 5/6 been up to?

We've had several exciting and educational weeks in Class 5/6 filled with a range of activities that have both challenged and engaged our students!

Our swimming lessons at Brixton Rec have continued to make a splash as we improved our techniques and water confidence.

In humanities we have been diving into the grim world of Tudor England and learning about crime and punishment in that era. From the stocks to the dunking stools, we explored how justice was served in the past, sparking some great discussions on how laws have changed over time.

In English we have continued our learning on 'The Three Little Pigs project' staging "pretend protests" to understand why the protestors might have felt so strongly about the crime.



We also wrote letters from the perspective of one of the little pigs, making sure to include subordinate clauses, parenthesis and relative clauses.

In maths, we've been exploring, place value, negative numbers, addition, subtraction and common factors, and finding connections between numbers in different ways. We've been using these skills to solve problems and improve our mathematical reasoning. Keep up the great work!

## What has Class 5/6 been up to?

In R.E we have been continuing with our 'Walk through the Bible' sessions with Chris Willis from Herne Hill Baptist Church, where we have been learning the Bible stories from the Old Testament, through music and drama.



In P.E, we've been focusing on football skills. We have been practicing dribbling, passing, and teamwork.



In art and design, we have been studying the artist Paul Klee and creating our very own pieces of art inspired by him!

It's been a fun and productive week, and we look forward to seeing even more progress from our amazing students!

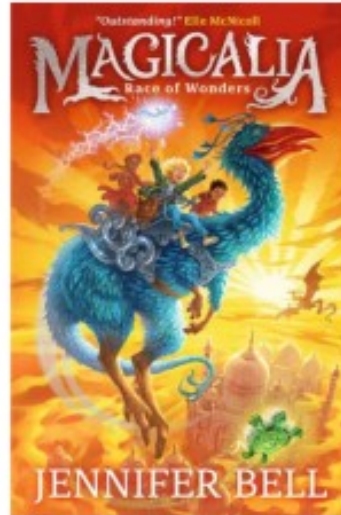

## Class 2

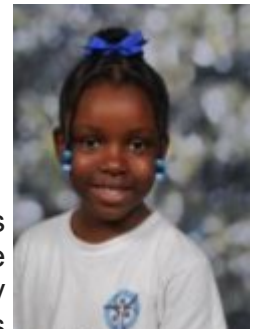

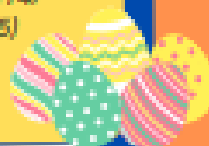
