English:

In English lessons we will be focusing on writing a range of text types this half term. We will be using 'Suffragette: The Battle for Equality' by David Roberts and 'The Invention of Hugo Cabret' by Brian Selznick to inspire our writing!

We will be practising:

- Writing from different characters' points of view.
- Using paragraphs correctly.
- Writing in the subjunctive
- Using Parenthesis
- Writing in the passive voice
- Assessing our own and others' writing for it effectiveness.

PE:

In our outside PE sessions, we will be honing our Rugby skills, looking at different techniques and playing matches. In our indoor P.E sessions, we will be looking at dance and fitness.

Science - Diet, Drugs and Lifestyle

Our science unit focuses on Diet, Drugs and Lifestyle. We will be exploring:

- The Heart and the circulatory system
- The effect drugs have on the human body
- The effect lifestyle has on the human body

RE - Who are the 'Fearless women of faith'?

We will be exploring, examining and comparing the different representations of women both in the Bible and in different walks of life and in the church. We will also be looking at a number of women both from the Bible and from different times to illustrate how women have been faithful to their beliefs and fought for racial and social justice.

Music:

- Multiplying and dividing fractions
- Finding a fraction of an amount

<u>Computing (Programming-repetition in shapes):</u>

In computing this half term, we will:

- Program a computer by typing commands
- Explain what 'repeat' means and predict the outcome of a program containing a controlled loop
